EVENTS SCHOOL BREAKFAST:



In the Fall and Spring the Fathers' Club cooks

and serves breakfast for the school. The girls, faculty and staff are offered eggs, pancakes, bacon, hash browns, muffins, yogurt, juice and coffee and more starting at 7am, which means the dads get started at **5:30am**. It is a lot of work in early hours, but also a lot of fun working together and interacting with the students – our daughters and their friends – and the teachers and administration. All appreciate the hearty meal to start their day.

NEW YORK CITY BUS TRIP:

The Fathers' Club organizes a tour bus trip to NYC for approximately \$55 per person. We leave early in the morning and allow for a full day of whatever you want to do in NYC: see a show, shop, sightsee and/or enjoy the

Big Apple decorated for Christmas. Snacks and drinks are provided on the bus. The trip is open to TCHS family and friends. Not only is this a convenient way to travel to NYC, but it also serves as a fundraiser for the Fathers' Club. The next trip is scheduled for **Sat.**, **Dec. 8**. Tickets will go on sale early in the school year.



FATHER/DAUGHTER DANCE:

This semi-formal dance is held in January. The event offers a chance for dads and daughters to have a special night out in style.

Formal pictures by the fireplace are available for purchase. A delicious dinner, refreshments and dessert are served buffet-style. A DJ provides music that both generations can dance to and enjoy – yes, many dads get out on the dance floor and their daughters are not embarrassed. At the end of the evening all the girls take home a gift bag, with seniors receiving and extra special gift. This event also serves as a fundraiser for the Fathers' Club even though tickets are only \$35 per person. The dance for this school year is on Sat., Jan. 19, 2019 from 8pm to Midnight. Tickets will go on sale in late fall.

FUNDRAISERS

Fathers' Club fundraisers are organized to gather additional resources to channel back to the school for specific purposes. TCHS Tuition Assistance **Program**, TCHS Annual **Gala**, **Treble makers** Fine Arts Committee and other purposes as decided by our committee. We currently have two non-event fundraisers.



SENIOR BANNERS: The Fathers' Club offers the chance for family, friends, fellow students, etc. to purchase a banner for a TCHS senior. The banners offer personalized messages to the graduating student. They are hung in the dining hall (by the

Fathers' Club) over Easter break so the girls can see the messages upon their return and the banners are on display during the last weeks of their time in school. The seniors can keep them as lifelong memories! The banners go on sale Feb.20 through April 5, 2019. The cost is \$30. The Fathers' Club organizes the orders, printing and hanging of the banners.



CRAB RAFFLE: This is a bonanza of a raffle for those who live around the Chesapeake and love steamed crabs. Beginning March 21 the Fathers' Club sells raffle tickets for a bushel of #1 crabs from a local vendor, two dozen ears of corn, one case of beer, one case of soda and a gift basket of accessories. The winner will be drawn at the last Fathers' Club meeting of the school year (May 23).

SERVICES



The Fathers' Club is often called upon to provide a variety of services for the school. We help in the parking lot at events, set up or clean up after school events, assist in set construction for school theater productions, and in other ways when the school needs **special skills** for a variety of projects.
